Description: This program will provide students with the knowledge and skills to enhance their employment prospects in the building and construction industry. It also provides them with a nationally recognised qualification as well as contribute toward their VCE or VCAL Certificate. A combination of both practical classroom learning and structured hands on learning. After successful completion of the VCE/VET program students will have fully completed their pre-apprenticeship certificate.

Contribution to the VCE/VCAL:

On completion of the program students are eligible for four credits towards their VCE, two at Unit1-2 level and a Unit 3-4 sequence. Students who successfully complete the Unit 3-4 sequence will be eligible for a 10% increment towards their ATAR.
