Description: This course is designed to develop the knowledge and skills required for the selection and coordination of interior furnishings and finishes in the decoration of domestic and commercial interiors. You will study interior decoration and learn the practical skills and knowledge required to plan and implement creative design and decoration solutions for a variety of interior environments.

You will also learn skills in computing, Google SketchUp, presentation methods, soft furnishings, hard material application, colour theory and application. You will have the opportunity to use Adobe design software throughout the program. You will create a folio of design work of art and design courses at tertiary level.

Contribution to the VCE/VCAL:

On completion of the program students are eligible for four credits towards their VCE, two at Unit 1-2 level and a Unit 3-4 sequence.

Students who successfully complete the Unit 3-4 sequence will be eligible for a 10% increment towards their ATAR.
