Description:

The course is designed to provide a 'hands on' learning environment and focuses on providing simulating and practical work experiences, employability skills and career pathways into the automotive industry as an apprentice.



Contribution to the VCE/VCAL:

On completion of the program students are eligible for four credits towards their VCE, two at Unit 1-2 level and a Unit 3-4 sequence. Students who successfully complete the Unit 3-4 sequence will be eligible for a **10% increment** towards their ATAR.
