**Description:** This program provides students with a wide range of knowledge and skills that will enable them to maximise their employment opportunities as a performer or composer in the music industry.

#### Contribution to the VCE/VCAL:

On completion of the program students are eligible for four credits towards their VCE, two at Unit 1-2 level and a Unit 3-4 sequence.

Students wishing to receive an ATAR contribution must undertake scored assessment for the purpose of achieving a study score. This study score can contribute directly to the primary four or as a fifth or sixth subject.
