



# FRANKSTON TRADE TRAINING CENTRE

## PROGRESS

The START Trade Training Centre is ready for full operation at the beginning of the 2015 school year.

## PROGRAMS

The state of the art new facility will host many of Chisholm's VETis programs including these new additions:

- Wall & Floor Tiling
- Painting & Decorating
- Wall & Ceiling Lining
- Joinery
- Shop fitting & Stair building

The TTC will also house specific training areas for

- Hair and Beauty,
- Plumbing and
- Patisserie.

As in previous years the VETis courses will predominantly run on Wednesdays & Fridays of the school term. To accommodate the volume of VETis students, Chisholm will be utilizing both the new START Trade Training Centre and existing Chisholm facilities.

An exciting new dimension to vocational education in the region will be available on Thursdays when programs will be geared to Year 9 and 10 students. Semester based and occasional single day programs will be offered that allow students to experience a range of different vocational areas before selecting a full Certificate program in subsequent years.



It has been confirmed that in Semester One 2015 the Thursday program will comprise a selection of modules from Hairdressing & Beauty, Cookery & Patisserie, Building & Joinery.

Schools will also have the option to negotiate with Chisholm to arrange a specific program to fit individual school needs.

eg Specific year level needs, Applied Learning Groups, Special needs students.

An option for students transitioning from VCE to VCAL in Semester 2, 2015 is currently being developed and School Based Apprenticeships & Traineeships in the TTC will also be a major focus going into 2015 and beyond.

## **SCHOOL ACCESS AND COSTS**

The 13 Consortium schools of the START Trade Training Centre have priority access to programs offered in the new TTC for the first period of enrolment – that is for enrolments completed by October 31, 2014. The non consortium schools will then access the remaining available spots.

The basic principle for enrolments will be as for previous years – taken in the order in which they are received. However to ensure equity between the 13 schools of the consortium, Chisholm will seek to balance enrolments across all schools and programs.

For enrolments after October 31, applications will be considered on a first come first in basis irrespective of school.

The consortium schools will also receive a discount of 20% on tuition costs to be published in PathFinder, but not materials.

## **NEW VETiS PROGRAMS TO BE OFFERED IN THE START TRADE TRAINING CENTRE IN 2015**

### **Certificate II in Building and Construction (Painting and Decorating)**

This program will introduce you to the fundamentals of painting and decorating. Students will learn the theory and practice behind paint application, workplace safety, staining and colour selection. The program is hands on and allows you to explore different career opportunities in painting and decorating.

### **Certificate II in Building and Construction (Wall and Floor Tiling)**

This program will introduce you to the basic concepts of wall and floor tiling. You will learn about surface preparation, the use of hand and power tools, waterproofing, laying tiles and preparing and applying grout. You will learn about the laying of tiles on both internal and external surfaces.

### **Certificate II in Building and Construction (Wall and Ceiling Lining)**

In this program you will be introduced to career pathways in wall and ceiling lining. You will learn about leveling surfaces, installing insulation, installing and stopping up plasterboard and cement sheeting and installing decorative mouldings such as cornices.

### **Certificate II in Joinery/Shopfitting/Stairbuilding (Pre---apprenticeship)**

This course will prepare graduates with the skills and knowledge for entry into an apprenticeship (Certificate III) within the joinery/shopfitting/stairbuilding industries. This course has a range of units which introduce the learner to basic skills and knowledge that underpin the Certificate III qualifications in Joinery/Shopfitting/Stairbuilding

## **TRADE TASTER PROGRAMS YRS 9 & 10**

These Taster Programs will be delivered over the course of the semester from 9.30am – 2.30pm on Thursdays, Semester One 2015.

It is intended that in Semester one of 2015 the START Trade Training Centre will deliver the following VET Taster Programs.

**Hairdressing &  
Beauty**

**Cookery &  
Patisserie**

**Building &  
Joinery**

- These programs are aimed for Year 9 and 10 students and are designed to meet the needs of students through the provision of experiences that can

help guide future Pathway Planning and studies.

- Participation will also provide a valuable guide to those students seeking to enter a Certificate II or III Vocational Training, VET, as part of their Year 10, VCE or VCAL programs in 2016.
- Programs will include Units of Competency so schools will be able to access 'band' funding where applicable.
- Applications will be taken through the Chisholm Schools Portal, on a first in first served basis.

As finance's have yet to be confirmed Chisholm believe the costing's for the Taster Programs will be approximately \$800---\$900 plus materials, per student per semester. Schools should note that band funding is available and should be able to access roughly half of these fess for students aged 15 years and above, as of May 15<sup>th</sup> 2015.

Semester 2, 2015 will have a different program on offer including **Plumbing & Metal, Painting & Decorating, & Electrical & Engineering**. Semester One Taster Programs may also be delivered based on demand.
