DANCE

Description: Classroom learning is combined with structured hands-on training and practice in industry. The aim of this program is to:

- Allow learners to develop basic technical skills to prepare for work in the live performance industry.
- Perform a combination of technical dance activities aligned to the Australian Qualifications Framework at Level II.
- Demonstrate proficiency in Jazz & Contemporary dance styles.

Contribution to the VCE/VCAL:

On completion of the program students are eligible for four credits towards their VCE, two at Unit 1-2 level and a Unit 3-4 sequence. Students wishing to receive an ATAR contribution must undertake scored assessment for the purpose of achieving a study score. This study score can contribute directly to the primary four or as a fifth or sixth subject.

What to bring:

Students are required to wear appropriate clothing for dance and a laptop.
