# BUILDING & CONSTRUCTION

#### Description:

This program will provide students with the knowledge and skills to enhance their employment prospects in the building and construction industry. It also provides them with a nationally recognised qualification as well as contribute toward their VCE or VCAL Certificate. A combination of both practical classroom learning and structured hands on learning. After successful completion of the VCE/VET program students will have fully completed their pre-apprenticeship certificate.

**Contribution to the VCE/VCAL:** Recognition of up to four VCE VET units at Units 1 and 2 level and a VCE VET Units 3 and 4 sequence. The VCE VET Building and Construction program does not offer scored assessment.
