COURSE DESCRIPTION

This qualification covers competencies for work entry program providing grounding in safety and basic skills and knowledge for work in any electrotechnology discipline.

Opportunities

Students may be introduced to the recognised trade callings in the construction industry and provide meaningful credit in an Electrotechnology industry Australian Apprenticeship. Possible job titles relevant to this qualification may include Electrical Trades Assistant, Trades assistant, Electrotechnology Career Start Trainee.

Entry requirements

- Minimum age requirement as 15 years or over to enrol
- Students need to be currently completing a senior secondary program VCE or VCAL, with at least one day per week timetabled to be on training during the normal school week.
- It is recommended that the participants have basic communication, literacy, numeracy skills that are sufficiently well developed for them to participate in the training.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) and Credit Transfer

If you have skills or knowledge gained through previous study or relevant experience, you may be eligible for Recognition for Prior Learning and/or Credit Transfer that reduces the amount of training needed to complete the course and will be discussed with you during the pre-training review.
