Description:

If you love food, are interested in hospitality and enjoy working with people, then this course is a great way to familiarise yourself with this fast paced industry. Throughout the course you will learn how to follow hygiene procedures, present and prepare food. You will also learn how to interact with guests in live café/restaurant service. Assessments are both practical and theory focused. Practical assessments occur in the kitchen and café/restaurant settings. Theory assessments may be a combination of written and online assignments, tests and practical application projects.

Contribution to the VCE/VCAL:

On completion of the program students are eligible for five credits towards their VCE, three at Unit 1-2 level and a Unit 3-4 sequence.

Students wishing to receive an ATAR contribution must undertake scored assessment for the purpose of achieving a **study score**. This study score can contribute directly to the primary four or as a fifth or sixth subject.
