Description:

This course offers the minimum qualification required to work in early childhood education and care settings with babies and children up to six years of age. Workers in this industry support the implementation of approved learning framework, support children's wellbeing, learning and development. It prepares students for centre-based, out-of-school hours, family day care and nanny roles and covers child development and how to foster and support children's emotional and educational wellbeing.

Contribution to the VCE/VCAL:

Students who receive a Units 3 and 4 sequence from CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education may be eligible for an increment towards their ATAR (10 per cent of the lowest study score in the primary four scaled studies).

We recommend students complete at least 60 hours in the first year of the course
