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#### Description:

Certificate II in Hospitality provides students with a limited range of hospitality operational skills and basic industry knowledge, as well as a pathway into work in various hospitality settings, such as restaurants, hotels, motels, catering operations, clubs, pubs, cafés and coffee shops.

Includes units such as prepare/serve espresso coffee, non-alcoholic beverages, food and beverage service, advice on food, and functional transactions

#### Contribution to the VCE/VCAL:

recognition of two or more units at Units 1 and 2 level and a Units 3 and 4 sequence.

*This program option comprises a minimum of 14 units of competency: seven compulsory units and a minimum of two elective units at the Units 1 and 2 level and five compulsory units at the Units 3 and 4 level*

- SITXFSA001 Use hygienic practices for food safety
- SITHACS001 Clean premises and equipment
- SITHFAB004 Prepare and serve non-alcoholic beverages
- SITHFAB005 Prepare and serve espresso coffee
- SITHFAB002 Provide responsible service of alcohol
- SITHACS003 Prepare rooms for guests
- SITXFIN001 Process financial transactions

### What to bring:

Students are required to wear Black pants and black polo. Black rubber soled school shoes. Details of uniform requirement will be sent out upon enrolment

### Structured Workplace Learning (SWL)

Eg: This course requires students to undertake 80 hours of Structured Workplace Learning, 40 hours each year.
