COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Certificate II in Plumbing will prepare students with the skills and knowledge for entry into an apprenticeship (Certificate III in Plumbing) in one of the various sectors of the plumbing industry. The course provides a consistent outcome for students with basic skills that allows for employment across all streams of plumbing.

Career Opportunities

Students may be introduced to the recognised trade callings in the plumbing industry and provide meaningful credit in a Plumbing industry Australian Apprenticeship. Possible job titles relevant to this qualification may include Construction Assistant, Builder's Labourer and Drainer.

Entry requirements

- Minimum age requirement as 15 years or over to enrol
- Students need to be currently completing a senior secondary program VCE or VCAL, with at least one day per week timetabled to be on training during the normal school week.
- It is recommended that the participants have basic communication, literacy, numeracy skills that are sufficiently well developed for them to participate in the training.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) and Credit Transfer

If you have skills or knowledge gained through previous study or relevant experience, you may be eligible for Recognition for Prior Learning and/or Credit Transfer that reduces the amount of training needed to complete the course and will be discussed with you during the pre-training review.
